## WHERE TO AFTERPARTY

### DRAY'S

**Where:** 3595 S Las Vegas Blvd.

The longest-running afterhours in Las Vegas may have moved a few times, but is still a go-to tourist destination for keeping the party going. Located in the basement of the Cromwell, celebrates 20 years of losing track of time amidst the red glow of the library-esque feel of the lounge and its four rooms. Expect plenty of big names to stop by for EDC Week.

### ARTISAN

**Where:** 1501 W. Sahara Ave.

Tucked away in the shadow of the I-15 just off Sahara, the Artisan is a charming escape from casinos and neon. With reproductions of famous artwork on every wall and even on the ceilings, the weekends have DJs until after the sun comes up.

### AFTER

**Where:** 1000 E. Sahara Ave.

The location may have changed, but the "DJ Rules" are still in effect. What rules exactly? Basically, stick to the underground sounds, all commercial EDM is banned. Expect special headliners and affordable drinks and cover charges at this Friday and Saturday night soiree a short distance from the Strip for a #ProperAfterhours with open bar specials amidst techno, house, tech house, deep house and minimal tunes.

### TERRACE AFTERHOURS

**Where:** 6007 Dean Martin Dr.

If you want to keep the party going but appreciate the sunrise, enjoy a set as you bust out the shades at Terrace Afterhours atop the Hustler Club. There's a separate side entrance for those wanting to avoid the strip club and local DJ Brett Rubin curates a night of house and techno to accompany the welcoming of a new day.

## FIX YOUR HANGOVER

### GRAND LUX CAFE

**Where:** 3355 S. Las Vegas Blvd.

Open 24-hours, you can either stumble out of bed for breakfast or try to preemptively stave off the impending doom with a late-night meal found on the extensive menu from the creators of the Cheesecake Factory. If you're in need of a hair of the dog, they've got that taken care of, too.

### HANGOVER HEAVEN

**Where:** 3281 S. Highland Dr., Suite 806

Say your whole group of friends is suffering in a bad way. You can call up the Hangover Heaven bus to supply your group with a rehydrating IV treatment. Or give them a call and they'll come pick you up from your hotel. Recommendations include the Myers Cocktail containing IV fluid, vitamin C, magnesium and 6 B vitamins. You can even get oxygen treatments.

### WICKED SPOON

**Where:** 3708 S Las Vegas Blvd.

### THE BUFFET AT WYNN
